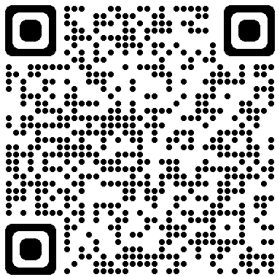
- pray for more people to come forward to join us in this ministry.
