
As I see it we could go out in small groups

- heading along Fore Street crossing at the University and walking along the waterfront,
- up Foundry Lane and along College Street at the roundabout turn and
- walk up St Peters Street praying for the small businesses there
- turning left into Cutler Street past the Diocesan Office in the St Nicholas Centre pray for those making decisions.
- cross over and head towards Cardinal Park praying through the area particularly for safety,
- head along Sedan walk towards Princes Street and Portman Road passing ITFC pray for those working within the ground both players and other staff, for Christians working in that community in particular.
- at the corner of Sir Alf Ramsey Way Pray for the local council and MPs
- turn right into Great Gipping street under Civic drive and along Elm Street turning left into Black Horse Lane
- on entering Westgate Street turn right and continue through the town until you reach St Helens Street turn right into Grimwade Street turning left just before Goals. Pray for the College as you pass it, for Students, staff etc you should be able to walk through the college car Park and out onto back Hamlet and back to Holy Trinity Church

Groups should feel free to change their route but please do cover as many of the areas as possible but I appreciate some may want a shorter route to follow.

The Important thing that God laid on my heart was that we should focus on the main centre of our town walking right through the main thoroughfare claiming the ground for people to be touched by Jesus as they go about their business!
